



# STORMWATER POLLUTION POSTER CONTEST

## CONTEST RULES

**Who Can Enter?** 4th & 5th grade students in Clark County.

**Why Enter?** To help teach others about stormwater pollution.

**When?** All entries must be received by March 5, 2010.

**How?** Send submissions through the school mail to Beverly Mason at the Partnership Program Office, or submit to Jennifer Szejbka, CDSN, 5820 S. Pecos Road, Suite A-400 Las Vegas NV 89120.

### Other Requirements:

- Artwork must be original; must not violate U.S. copyright law and becomes the property of CDSN and will not be returned.
- Each poster must be clearly labeled with the following information: Student Name, Grade, Teacher's Name, School, Poster Title.
- Poster must use the theme "How you can prevent stormwater pollution," and include a brief message and/or picture that supports this theme. Image should be large enough to be easily seen and understood. Posters will be judged on originality, artwork, and message delivery.
- Poster size must be between 8.5" x 11" and 22" x 28".

**Prizes:** The winner and their entire class will receive a field trip on the Forever Earth environmental science houseboat on Lake Mead either April 21 or May 13, 2010. Lunch will be provided. The winning student will also receive a special prize to recognize their accomplishment. Second Place winner will receive a classroom visit from the educators at Shark Reef Aquarium. Third and fourth places will receive goody bags.
